Water transfer from OSIE to OWIE

Approval has been received from NRAR for installation of temporary pipes across the waterfront lands at Ropes Creek. These pipes will be used to transfer potable water from a mains connection at the Oakdale South Site and for transfer of water from the OSIE Water Quality Basins to holding basins at the OWE site.
